The amended announcement should read:



This dividend distribution comprises US\$0.108 per unit made out of Singapore tax-exempt dividends, and US\$0.122 per unit made out of other dividends (foreign taxable dividends and foreign tax-exempt dividends). The Fund is an exchange-traded fund listed on the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited.

The Ex-dividend date is 1 April 2010 and the record date is 6 April 2010. The distribution will be payable on 16 April 2010.

Distributions to investors in respect of units registered in their names will be paid directly into their bank accounts or by cheque and sent by post to the investors' address registered with The Central Depository (Pte) Ltd.

The investment objective of the Fund is to replicate as closely as possible the performance of the FTSE Asean 40 Index.
